Choupina for reporting on 15 July 2013 three separate SQL injection vulnerabilities in different campus departmental web servers, and allowing us time to correct the issue before making this information more widely known.

Vulnerabilities such as SQL injection are considered breaches of campus systems, and all laws and campus policies are followed in responding to such breaches, including breach notification of affected parties (if applicable).
